An additional target should be a fruitful balance between individual creativity and collaborative decisions. Collaboration between UX designers and developers is also playing an increasingly important role. Strategies to foster this collaborative design process are crucial to ensure an efficient and future-proof way of working.

Together, we would like to find out which systems can support us in everyday life and on a global level to cope with the problems of our time. We are particularly looking forward to presentations that raise controversial questions or present unusual approaches.

Our WUD is intended to be a forum for all those who are committed to good usability and conducive interaction between people and technology. As Michelangelo already recognised with the ceiling of the Sistine Chapel, cooperation is the key to success. In this spirit, we look forward to an inspiring WUD 2023.

What should your submission include?

- Of course, we need to know who you are, so we need your name and, if applicable the name of the **company/university** you work for.
- We need to know how to reach you, so we need your address, phone number and e-mail address. Of course, this information will be kept strictly confidential and only used in the context of our organisational work for the WUD.
- We need to know what you want to present, so we need the title and a half- to one-page summary of your presentation/workshop. Please note: Presentations should not exceed 30 minutes. We recommend a division into 20 minutes presentation and 10 minutes discussion. Workshops should last about 2 hours, but we can be more flexible than with presentations.
- Contributions should be held in German.

Once you have sent us your submission, we will contact you by Friday, September 15 th, 2023 at the latest.
